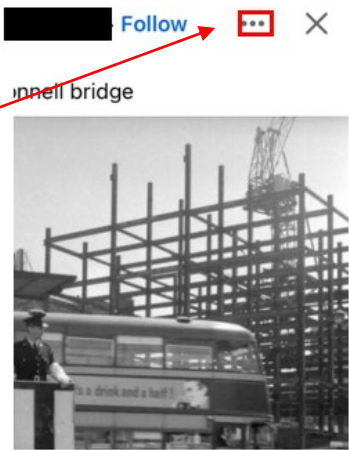
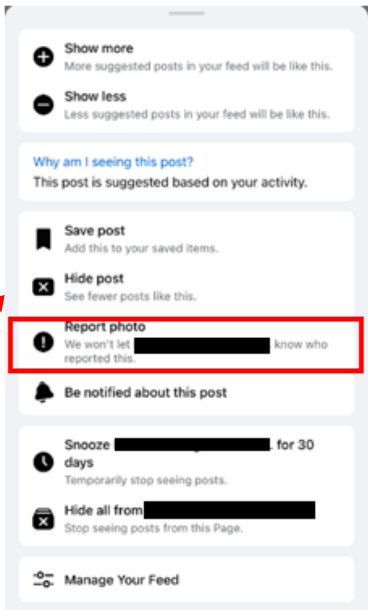


Reporting Illegal Content on Facebook

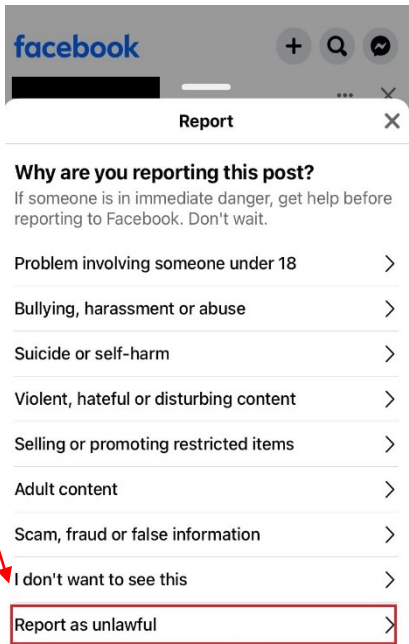
Step 1: Click on the ellipsis or three dots on the top right-hand corner of the post.



Step 2: Click on 'Report'.

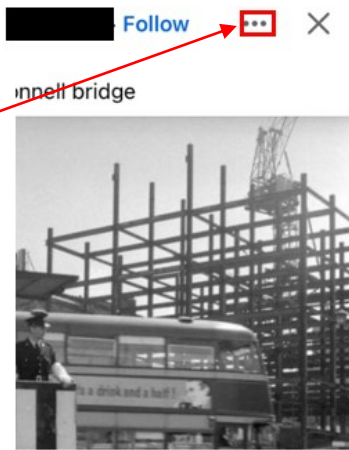


Step 3: Select 'Report as unlawful'.

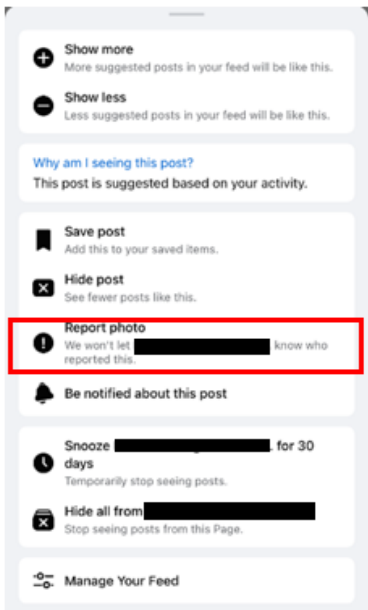


Reporting Harmful Content on Facebook

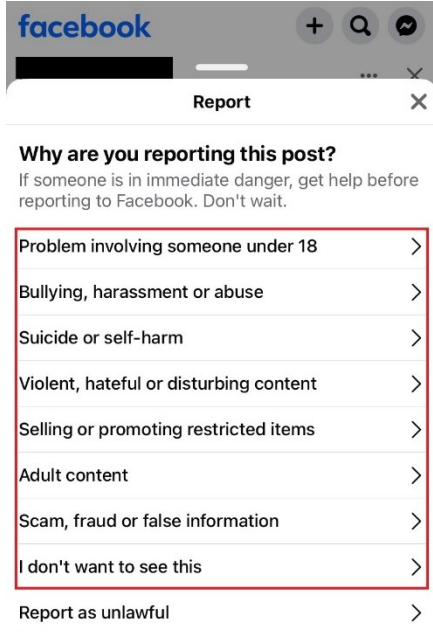
Step 1: Click on the ellipsis or three dots on the top right-hand corner of the post.



Step 2: Click on 'Report'.




Step 3: Select an option (other than 'Report as unlawful') to explain why the content potentially violates Facebook's Community Standards.


Step 4: Select 'Content is unlawful for another reason' (for non- IP, defamation and privacy/erasure under GDPR issues).

The 'Legal Removal Request' form contains the following sections:

- Legal Removal Request**
- Introduction: This form is intended for reporting content posted on Facebook that you believe violates your personal legal rights or applicable local laws.
- Content to report: Please note that the content you'd like to report may violate our: Community Standards (e.g.: bullying, harassment, hate speech), Advertising Policies, Commerce Policies.
- Country: Select the country where you are claiming legal rights. (Ireland selected)
- Legal issue: What legal issue do you wish to report?
 - Intellectual Property (example: copyright, trademark)
 - Defamation
 - Privacy / Erasure under GDPR
 - I believe content violates a law not mentioned above (example: hate speech)
- Specific laws: What specific laws do you believe are violated by the reported content? Please include links (URLs) or citations to the text of the laws.
- Reason for violation: Why do you believe this content violates the specific laws you believe to be violated? Please explain which specific laws you believe are violated by the reported content.
- Upload: Please upload a copy of the investigation, legal action, or decision. (Choose Files button)
- Reporting on behalf of: Who are you reporting on behalf of?
 - I am reporting on behalf of myself
 - I am reporting on behalf of my organization
 - I am an attorney or other representative authorized to report on behalf of my client
- Personal information: Your first name, Your last name, Email address, Confirm email address.
- Additional options: I don't have an email address, Continue with your report
- Links: Please provide links (URLs) to each piece of content on Facebook. (Example: https://www.facebook.com/DublinRunningMeetupGro)
- More links: I have more links (URLs) to report, I don't have links (URLs) leading directly to the content I want to report, Continue with your report
