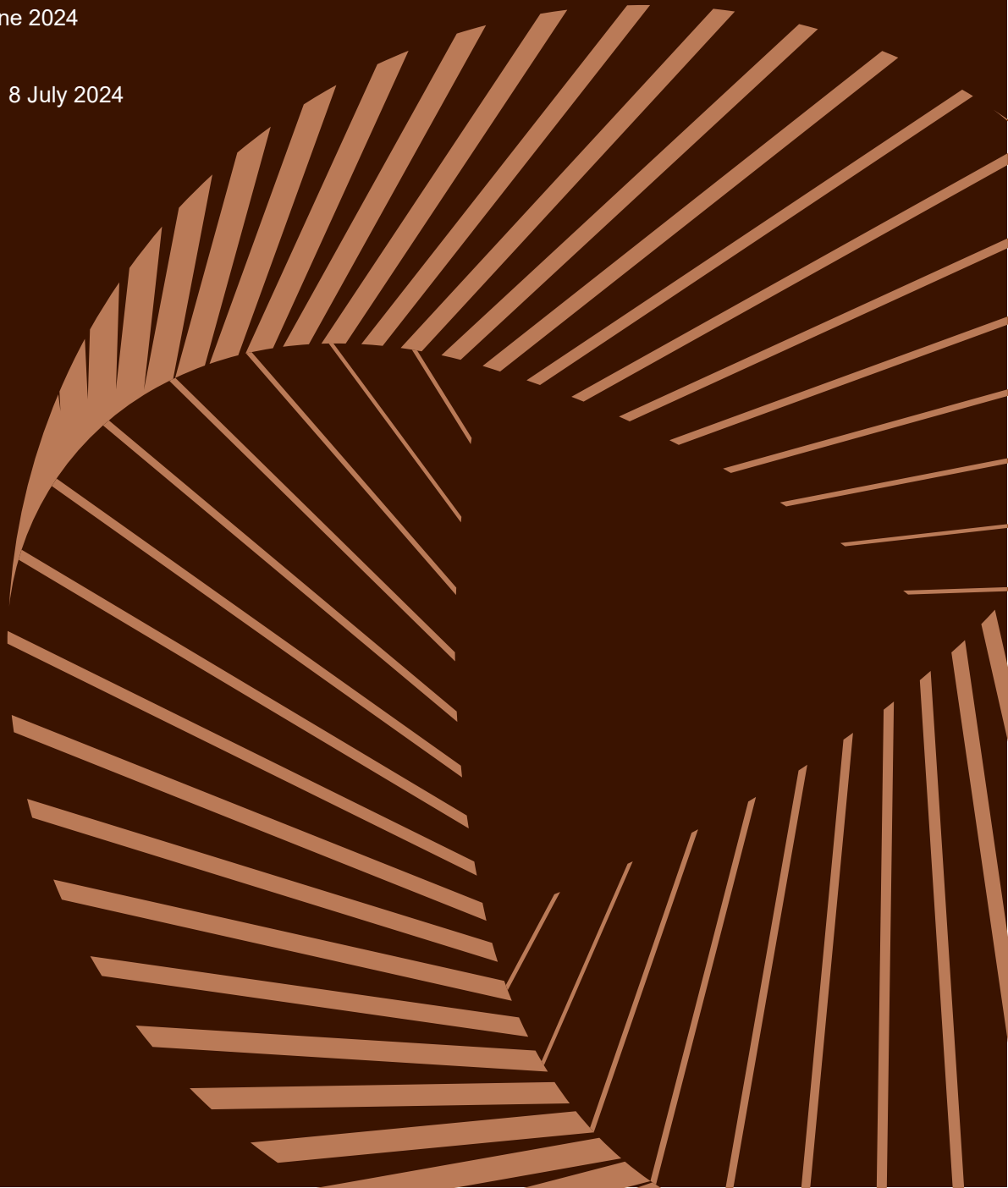
Guide to Submissions

STATEMENT OF INTENT

for a Sound Broadcasting Contract for the provision of local services for Cork City and County

Publication date: 10 June 2024

Deadline for response: 8 July 2024



Introduction

- 1.1 The sound broadcasting contract for the provision of two services on the FM band: 1) a broad-format local service; and 2) a music-driven local service for the franchise area of Cork City and County (“the Contract”), currently held by County Media Limited and broadcasting as 1) C103 and 2) Cork’s 96 FM is due to expire on 30 April 2025.
- 1.2 In accordance with Section 65(6) of the Broadcasting Act 2009 as amended (“the 2009 Act”), Coimisiún na Meán (“the Commission”) placed a notice in a national newspaper and on its website, on 21 March 2024 seeking expressions of interest for the Contract. By the closing date on 20 May 2024, the only expression of interest received was from the current holder of the sound broadcasting contract, County Media Limited.
- 1.3 The Commission assessed the expression of interest at its meeting on 6 June 2024. The Commission considered the respondent to be the incumbent and the submission to be made in good faith. In these circumstances, the Commission decided to invoke the fast-track procedure under Section 67(2) of the 2009 Act for the award of the Contract.
- 1.4 Accordingly, on 10 June 2024, the Commission placed a public notice in a national newspaper circulating in Cork City and County¹ and on its website stating its intention to invoke the fast-track application process for the award of the Contract.
- 1.5 Potential respondents must make a submission by **12 noon on 8 July 2024**, stating that they wish to apply for the award of the Contract (“Statement of Intent”).
- 1.6 The Statement of Intent must be accompanied by a deposit of **€20,000**, which is refundable if an application is subsequently submitted to the Commission pursuant to an invitation to apply for the Contract issued under Section 65(8) of the 2009 Act.
- 1.7 The Statement of Intent must be submitted in the format specified in Section 2 of this document.
- 1.8 If the Commission receives a Statement of Intent and the required deposit, the Commission will proceed to invite applications for the award of the Contract. If an invitation to apply for the award of the contract is issued, the term of the Contract, if awarded, will be ten (10) years.
- 1.9 An indicative guide for the application for a sound broadcasting contract under Section 65(8) of the 2009 Act is available on the Commission’s website or on request from licensing@cnam.ie
- 1.10 Statements of Intent may be published on the Commission’s website once they have been considered, and the next stage in the process is determined by the Commission.

Procedures for Submitting a Statement of Intent

- 2.1 A statement of intent form is available to potential respondents from the Commission's website, www.cnam.ie or on request from licensing@cnam.ie or (01) 6441200. If you choose not to use the form please ensure that your submission adheres to the format outlined hereunder and that you provide all the information requested.

By submitting your Statement of Intent you are confirming the following to the Commission: -

- that you have read and understood the *Guide to Submissions: Statement of Intent for a Sound Broadcasting Contract for local services for Cork City and County*;
- that a deposit of €20,000 has been paid into the Commission's bank account; and
- that you consent to your Statement of Intent being made public.

- 2.2. The format for a Statement of Intent is as follows:

2.2.1 Respondent:

- (a) Please provide a general description of the person/entity making the statement.
- (b) Please provide your contact details: contact person's name, address, telephone, and email.

2.2.2 Details of the Sound Broadcasting Contract:

- (a) Please identify the relevant franchise area as **Cork City and County**.
- (b) Please identify the sound broadcasting services as: **1) a Broad-Format Local Service; and 2) a Music-Driven Local Service for the 25-44 Age Group**.

2.2.3 Details of Statement of Intent:

The text of the Statement of Intent is to be as follows: -

2.2.3 You must **sign and date** the Statement of Intent.

2.4 Payment of the Cash Deposit:
